



Interface view (i.e., external view) of information model for SCM Version Control System.

THE ALF COMMON Subject area is a separate vocabulary for types and structures that occur in many different vocabularies. ALF COMMON serves as a way to increase interoperability among vocabularies by “factoring out” common concepts. It may turn out that there is no specific interface or operations for the entity types in the ALF COMMON subject area and that they simply define structures that are incorporated into entity types in other vocabularies. Typical types of entity types that appear in ALF Common include: organizational structures, individuals (i.e. User), time and duration designations, calendars, etc
