What's New Portlets can be lists of articles (length determined by the content manager) that can be published anywhere in the site.

Main elements for all what's new content include: author, title (document title), a body (main page content), a level (path), a brief description (teaser), a log date (date entered/modified), a publishing date (date displayed), a unique id, workflow status (active/in development), keywords (for search purposes), a display (layout)

What's New portlets are dynamically generated and automatically updated. They also provide and XML feed

The Contribution Questionnaire is the first step in initiating the due diligence and approval process by the Eclipse Management Organization (EMO) for any significant contribution of content to be committed to an Eclipse project. Prior to completing this Questionnaire, the Committer should have technical agreement from the PMC that the new code is required. Once the PMC has approved, the Committer, with the assistance of one or more of the contributors, may begin the EMO due diligence and approval process by completing and submitting this questionnaire. What is meant by a significant contribution? Any initial code contribution used to kick off a new project. By definition, this code has been written elsewhere and it needs to be reviewed.				
or Any contribution authored by someone other than a committer which is adding new functionality to the codebase. In most cases, bug fixes do not add new functionality although it's not impossible.				
or Any contribution containing third-party code maintained by another open source project, individual, group, or organization. In addition to reviewing the contribution, if the license is not the Eclipse Public License (EPL) , the EMO will need to review and approve the third-party license for compatibility with the EPL.				
NOTE: A questionnaire and approval is not required for bug fixes or minor enhancements.
