

Termination Review for Tools for Mobile Web project

History

Tools for Mobile Web (TMW) was proposed in Spring 2010. The project was reviewed and accepted as a sub-project of Sequoyah in Fall 2010 with an initial contribution from Symbian. The project was begun with Paul Beusterien and Eugene Ostroukhov from Symbian as the initial committers.

Issues with the project

- A total of 4 bugs have been logged to bugs.eclipse.org ([328292](#), [328498](#), [329278](#), [327960](#))
- Minimal activity on [tmw-dev](#)
- All committers who started the project have left their employers and no other parties have offered to maintain the project
- The project web pages reference material on the Symbian Foundation web site that no longer exists (e.g. [Web Runtime](#))
- Downloads and documentation pages display “Coming Soon”

Request for Termination

As stated in the [Eclipse Development Process](#) “*The purpose of a Termination Review is to provide a final opportunity for the Committers and/or Eclipse membership to discuss the proposed withdrawal of a Proposal or archiving of a Project. The desired outcome is to find sufficient evidence of renewed interest and resources in keeping the Project or Proposal active.*”

It is in that spirit, the Sequoyah project requests a Termination Review of the Tools for the Mobile Web project. As TMW did not graduate out of incubation and did not gain a community of users or downstream adopters, we request that the process be expedited.

Cessation of Termination

For TMW to continue as a project, a new Project Leader and committers are required. A reliable indication of interest from contributors needs to occur and a new plan of action needs to be enacted.

Termination Actions

In the event new committers and project leads are not found, the termination review will proceed according to the [Eclipse Development Process](#). Once the procedures are completed, the following actions will occur:

1. Directories archived and removed from git([git.eclipse.org/gitroot/tmw](#))
2. Open Bugzilla bugs marked “won't fix” and the bugzilla component archived
3. Website archived <http://www.eclipse.org/tmw/>
4. Mailing list tmw-dev set to read-only
5. Any open CQ items are withdrawn
