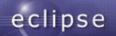
Introduction

- JPA Diagram Editor is an Eclipse editor meant to easily create, view and edit JPA domain models in form of diagrams
- A <u>component</u> in the WTP Incubator project
- Released <u>version 0.5.0</u> on Dec 1st, 2010. This release is compatible with Helios.



Goal of this review

- Graduate the JPA Diagram Editor component from the WTP Incubator and move it to the WTP Dali project
- The next major release will be with the Indigo simultaneous release as a component of the Dali project



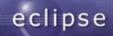
Graduation (1/4)

- JPA Diagram Editor is a contribution by SAP of a mature software, used in SAP products and shipped to customers
- Pre-graduation release 0.5.0, based on Helios
 - <u>53 bugs</u> fixed
- No API released yet no adopter requested one.
 - All packages are "internal" API
 - New API can be released on adopter's request



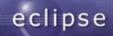
Graduation (2/4)

- The JPA Diagram Editor has a build dependency to the Graphiti project
 - Graphiti will join the Indigo simultaneous release, but still incubating
 - WTP PMC decided in exceptional cases a component of a WTP project can depend on an incubating project
 - WTP PMC approved that the JPA Diagram Editor can graduate into the Dali project with the current dependency to the incubating Graphiti project
 - See the complete WTP PMC <u>meeting minutes</u>



Graduation (3/4)

- Milestones delivered regularly
 - Initial contribution August 11th, 2010
 - 0.5.0 RC1 August 18th, 2010
 - 0.5.0 RC2 September 15th, 2010
 - 0.5.0 RC3 October 19th, 2010
 - 0.5.0 Release December 1st, 2010
- Next Release aligned with the Indigo schedule (as part of Dali)



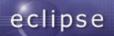
Graduation (4/4)

Move (1/4)

- As part of the graduation, the JPA Diagram Editor moves to the WTP Dali project.
- Code repository
 - /cvsroot/webtools/incubator/org.eclipse.jpt should move to /cvsroot/webtools/org.eclipse.jpa/components/jpa_diagram_editor

 - <u>4446</u> easymock Version: 2.4
 - <u>4463</u> JPA (Javax Persistence Jar) Version: 1.0



Move (2/4)

- Committers
 - Stefan Dimov current committer, will become a committer in the Dali project
 - Petya Sabeva major contributor, will be proposed as a new committer in the Dali project
- Bugzilla
 - All bugs from WTP Incubator > wtp.inc.jpaeditor should move to a new component "JPA Diagram Editor" under the Dali JPA Tools product



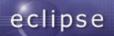
Move (3/4)

- Web pages
 - The content of the current wiki page will be integrated with the existing Dali web site
- Newsgroups/Forums
 - The existing <u>Dali forum</u> will be used
- Mailing lists
 - The existing <u>Dali mailing list</u> will be used



Move (4/4)

- Builds
 - The JPA Diagram Editor will be integrated with the existing PDE build of WTP in order to be built and released together with the rest of WTP components
 - The component team may decide to have a Hudson build job in parallel for ease of development reasons



Indigo

- The main focus of the JPA Diagram Editor for Indigo will be <u>adding support for JPA 2.0 entities</u>
- The JPA Diagram Editor will be released as an optional feature of WTP Dali
 - Will be included in the Indigo Discovery Site
 - Will not be included in the Eclipse IDE for Java EE Developers EPP package until Graphiti graduates
